RULES OF THE EVENT:

Article 1 - The Amateur Sports Association Centro Atletica Celle Ligure, with the participation of the Liguria Region - Department of Sport and Leisure, the collaboration and sponsorship of the Municipalities of Celle Ligure and Varazze, of the Province of Savona and the Ligurian Regional Committee FIDAL and in collaboration with the Amateur Sports Associations ATLETICA ARCOBALENO SAVONA, ATLETICA VARAZZE, US PONT DONNAS, ATHLE TEAM GENOVA, CFFSD COGOLETO ATLETICA, ATLETICA BUGELLA BIELLA, ATLETICA CASORATE PRIMO, ATLETICA RUN FINALE LIGURE, ATLETICA OVADESE ORMIG organizes an international athletics event on track, called:

Article 2 - The event, as provided for in the FIDAL National Calendar, will take place on **Wednesday, July 17, 2024**, in Celle Ligure (SV), at the Giuseppe Olmo-Pino Ferro Sports Centre located in Natta Resort, with a program reserved for absolute and youth categories.

There are also activities dedicated to Paralympic athletes, in collaboration with FISPEs.

The sports facilities are equipped with track and platforms made of synthetic material: athletes will have to wear shoes with nails no longer than 5 mm. *Checks will be carried out.*

Article 3 - The technical programme is as follows:

Race program:

Youth:

U14 F : 60 – 800 – Vortex
U14 M: 60 – 800 – Vortex
U16 F: 80 – 300 – 800 – Shot Put – High Jump – Long Jump
U16 M: 80 – 300 – 800 – Shot Put – High Jump – Long Jump

OVER16 MEN: 100 – 200 – 400 – 800 – 110hs – 400hs – High Jump – Long Jump – Shot Put
OVER16 WOMEN: 100 – 200 – 400 – 800 – 100hs – 400hs – High Jump – Long Jump

"Open" races extra International Program:

OVER16 MEN: 100 – 800
OVER16 WOMEN: 100 – 800

UNDER18 enrolled in the races (except for the races of 100hs and 110hs for which it is planned to carry out a series "dedicated" with hurdles at category heights) will be included in the absolute series of each discipline, based on individual 2023/24 SB.

In the disciplines of 100 m and m. 800, both female and male, there is the dispute of some extra series in time before (100) and after (800) the international section of the Meeting.

All races will be held in series. Those of the international program will be defined by the Organizers based on the participation proposals received.

All races of the technical program for the OVER16 sector will be carried out using distances, heights and tools provided for the Seniores category.

while the race of 400m F is combined with the
"33 ATHLETIC TROPHY"
- 5) The "13° GIAN MARIO DELUCIS TROPHY" is combined with the races of the 100 floors M/F
and is reserved for Athletes category "Under 20", registered for Ligurian teams

Paralympic races and for disabled athletes:

24° TROPHY TOGETHER IN SPORT - Agostino De Mari Foundation
100 m and 400 m - FISPE Paralympic Races (Athletes/ and wheelchair - Athletes/ and amputees)
50 m – Vortex – Special Olympics athletes

Article 4 - In addition to Italian and foreign Athletes invited by the Organizers, Athletes and Athletes regularly registered with FIDAL for the year 2024 can participate in the event.

Article 5 - Entries:

Entries to the competitions included in the international program are free.

For all other races (including the "extra" series of m. 100 and 800 both male and female), there is a registration fee of Euro 3.00 per race.

The Companies can arrange for the payment of the aforementioned shares by bank transfer, to be made by 15 July 2024, using the IBAN: **IT88F 05387 49361 00004 73477 95**

Regarding the OVER16 categories, except as indicated above, Clubs and Athletes are invited to propose the registration to the individual disciplines of athletes interested to participate. It will be the responsibility of the Organization of the Meeting to prepare the specific lists and ensure to find, at the end of the pre-registration, how many have proposed.

This specification is NOT valid for 100 and 800 disciplines, both male and female, open to all.

With regard to invitational races of the international program, as well as for the races of 100 and 800 meters (both male and female) reserved for absolute categories, interested athletes can

As for youth competitions and those for the disciplines of 100 and 800 for OVER16 categories, registrations must be made, **by 24 hours of the day 11/07/2024**, through the online procedure at <http://tessonline.fidal.it/>.

Please note that we will not accept registrations on the field, or those received after the deadline indicated.

Entries must be confirmed by an Executive of each participating Company at the General Secretariat (ICT) at least one hour before the start of each race (for youth competitions) and at least two **hours before the start (for absolute races)**. **Unsubstantiated entries will be void.**

Article 6 - The collection of race numbers will take place at the General Secretariat/ICT (Technical Information Centre) of the sports facility.

For all races there is only one race number to be applied on the chest. For jumping races the race number can be applied on the chest or back. The pectorals must be applied in their original size, without being reduced or bent.

The ICT, active from 13:00 on 17 July 2024, is located at the entrance of the race field and is the only point of reference and the link between Company, Organization and Race Management. Companies can contact ICT for:

- Pick up the pectoral bags;
- Submit official complaints, in second instance, in writing, accompanied by the related fee of €100.00
- Request clarification about the Regulations or the results.

Article 7 - Athletes and Athletes, after confirming the registration as provided for by article 5 of these Rules, must, without further call, report to the Appeal Chamber (located near the heating zone behind the stands) equipped with a federal card or a valid identity document for entry into the field in the following ways:

- 20' before the scheduled time for the start of the race;
- 30' before the scheduled time for the start of the competitions.

The actual time of entry into the field is set by the Meeting Management. There will be no speaker call.

As for racing, the fully automatic electric timekeeping will be in operation.

The athletes enter the field of competition exclusively through the Chamber of Appeal accompanied by a judge. The exit of all athletes takes place exclusively through the Zona Mista (placed after the general arrivals line) under the guidance of a judge, at the end of the race or at the completion of each round. It is not allowed to other people outside of Athletes, Judges, Organizers, Doctor and Photographers authorized, to access the race field.

Special workstations will be set up inside the facility for the technicians of athletes and athletes enrolled in competitions, limited to the disciplines of high jump and throw weight).

Athletes must wear the social jersey both in the race and during the award ceremony and can not bring into the field material not allowed by current regulations (mobile phones, radio transmitters, iPod, etc.). It is also recalled that no form of advertising other than that permitted by the RTI is allowed.

Article 8 - Allocation of lanes, jump and launch shifts, will be determined by the Technical Delegate at the Secretariat, immediately after confirmation of registrations by Athletes and Athletes.

The crediting times of the competitors will be verified and will be valid as objective but not decisive elements for the purpose of the composition of the series to which the Technical Delegate will provide with the support of the Meeting Director.

The Technical Delegate will also have the right to determine the progression of heights relative to the high jump competitions provided in the competition program, evaluated the number of athletes and the technical performance declared.

For details of the individual races and the composition of the series, please refer to the Regulations published on the federal website.

Article 9 - Tests available to Athletes in Competitions:

- Categories Boys and Girls. Competitions: each athlete will be entitled to 3 tests.
- Cadet and cadet categories. Competitions: each athlete will be entitled to 4 tests.
- Absolute Categories. Competitions: each athlete will be entitled to 3 qualifying tests. Athletes and Athletes who have performed the best 8 performances will be admitted/ and to the finals and can perform 3 additional tests.

Article 10 - Personal tools.

Gear must be delivered to the Call Room for inspection at least 75 minutes before the reference race. The judge will issue a receipt. If approved, they will be delivered to the field by the Technical Department and can be picked up only at the end of the race upon delivery of the receipt.

Article 11 - The general timetable of the event is as follows:

13.00 - Meeting of juries and competitors - Withdrawal of race numbers

13.45 - Closing confirmation races scheduled at 14:45 (for the other youth races confirmation possible up to an hour from the start, while for the absolute races the confirmation must be made within two hours from the beginning)

14.45 - Start of races

Note: The schedule, which is defined in detail in the table below, may be modified at the sole discretion of the Technical Delegate, on the basis of participants in each individual race and/ or for television needs.

Article 12 - Any complaints must be submitted to the Arbitrators of the tenders to which they relate in the first instance, and to the Court of Appeal, in the second instance within the terms indicated by the RTI (RT 8 and point 13 of the Activity Rules 2024) and after payment of the fees provided for by current federal legislation.

Article 13 - The first three Athletes and Athletes classified in each race will be awarded. The "WACT Prize Money" award table, which forms an integral part of these Regulations, has been prepared for the absolute competitions of the international programme.

Article 14 - There are additional prizes and incentives duly explained at www.meetingarcobaleno.it

Article 15 -Please note that in the following competitions, included in the technical program of the Meeting, special rankings will be drawn up and specific awards will be made for athletes and athletes belonging to the categories **Students (Under 18):**

- **100m and 110hs Student**
- **100m and 100hs Student**

It is also noted that all races scheduled for the absolute categories are still open to athletes and athletes of the categories Junior Students Promises Seniors Master.

Article 16 - Hotel accommodation and logistical news: interested parties may report to the Organizers, at the address indicated in Art. 5 of these Rules.

Article 17 - Other useful news to the Clubs and Athletes and Athletes will be made known promptly with subsequent communications.

Article 18 - As far as not covered by these Rules, the technical and statutory rules of FIDAL apply for the current year, except for any exceptions.
